

Colonoscopy Prep Instructions – Extended Prep – Clenpiq/Plenvu/Bisacoc

VOLIR ROWEL PREP IS VERY IMPORTANT. Please read immediately and review instructions carefully! Only follow these MDTFC instructions for your prep

Prior to your procedure:	f you do not follow these instructions and you are not prepped properly for your procedure, a cancellation fee will apply.

pharmacy after your pre-op call or office visit has been completed. Please pick up your prescription within 72 hours. Purchase Bisacodyl from the pharmacy. You will need to arrange for a responsible adult to drive you home. You cannot drive until the day after your procedure. A taxi, ride share, or shuttle is not an approved means of transportation unless you have a family member or friend with you. If you take Phentermine — stop taking this 10 days prior to your procedure. If you take iron, dietary, herbal or fiber supplements, stop taking these 7 days orior to your procedure. If you take a blood thinner— Please contact the prescribing doctor to obtain a blood thinner hold order. The office can fax this order to us at 410-972-2698. If you see a specialist: you can request that your most recent visit summary, labs, and test results from that office be faxed to us at 410-972-2698 If you develop any covid, flu, or cold like symptoms within 2 weeks of your procedure date, please call us at 410-224-3636.	cop consuming all food with eds, corn and nuts 5 days or to your procedure. Acceptable clear liquids include: water, clear broth, apple juice, white cranberry juice, white grape juice, soda, jello, popsicles, coffee, and tea. You may have any transparent liquid. Nothing with milk or creamer. Nothing red, blue or purple in color are allowed. 6pm: Clenpiq Prep- (Part 1) Step 1-Drink 1st bottle of Clenpiq solution. Shake well prior to drinking. Drink all of the solution in the bottle. Step 2- Drink five 8oz glasses of clear liquid (total of 40oz). Drink each 8oz every 15 minutes. It should take you no more than 1 hour to complete these steps. After completing this part of the prep take 10 mg of Bisacodyl (2 tablets –5mg each. If you are unable to tolerate the prep, please	Clear liquid diet continues all day today. 7am: Clenpiq Prep- (Part 2) Step 1-Drink 1st bottle of Clenpiq solution. Shake well prior to drinking. Drink all of the solution in the bottle. Step 2- Drink five 8oz glasses of clear liquid (total of 40oz). Drink each 8oz every 15 minutes. It should take you no more than 1 hour to complete these steps. 6pm: Plenvu Prep- (Part 1): Step 1-Empty Dose 1 Pouch in container. Add 16oz. water. Mix with spoon to dissolve. Step 2- Drink solution until all solution has been consumed within 30 minutes. Step 3- Refill container with 16oz water and drink slowly over 30 minutes. After completing this part of the prep take 10 mg of Bisacodyl (2 tablets -5mg each. If your prep results are not getting to a transparent	Clear liquid diet until 4 hours prior to your procedure. Morning Dose of Clenpiq: (Part 2) 5 hours prior to your procedure. Step 1-Drink 2nd bottle of Clenpiq solution. Shake well prior to drinking. Drink all of the solution in the bottle. Step 2- Drink five 8oz glasses of clear liquid (total of 40oz). Drink each 8oz every 15 minutes. It should take you no more than 1 hour to complete these steps. You must finish all of the prep, including the water 4 hours prior to your procedure. Please call the office if your prep results are not clear like water or a transparent yellow at this time. You cannot have ANYTHING AT ALL by mouth for at least 4 hours prior to scheduled procedure time. This includes ice, water, gum, hard candy and mints. No smoking the day of procedure. Please remember to bring your: -Current Medication list with the last dose for each medication taken -Insurance Cards -Driver's License/Photo ID -Any co-insurance fees that are due.
