


Colonoscopy Prep Instructions – Sigmoidoscopy with Colyte and Fleets Enema

VOLIR ROWEL PREP IS VERY IMPORTANT - Please read immediately and review instructions carefully! Only follow these MDTEC instructions for your prep.

		1	<u> </u>	Procedure Dav
Prior to your procedure: Your prescription is sent to your pharmacy after your pre-op call or office visit has been completed. Please pick up your prescription within 72 hours. Purchase Fleets enemas from the pharmacy. You will need to arrange for a responsible adult to drive you home. You cannot drive until the day after your procedure. A taxi, ride share, or shuttle is not an approved means of transportation unless you have a family member or friend with you. If you take Phentermine — stop taking this 10 days prior to your procedure. If you take weekly injections for weight loss for Diabetes: do NOT take this within 7 days of your procedure. If you take iron, dietary, herbal or fiber supplements, stop taking these 7 days prior to your procedure. If you take a blood thinner-please contact the prescribing doctor to obtain a blood thinner hold order. The office can fax this order to us at 410-972-2698. If you see a specialist: you can request that your most recent visit summary, labs, and test results from that office be faxed to us at 410-972-2698	Avoid consuming all food with seeds, corn and nuts 5 days prior to your procedure. Stop taking all NSAIDS. Ibuprofen, Advil, Aleve, etc. 5 days prior to your procedure. You may take Tylenol as needed. Inhalers and Nasal Spray-Continue as prescribed. Please bring with you on day of procedure. Blood Pressure and other essential medications: Continue as prescribed. Take these medications on the day of your procedure with a SMALL sip of water at least 2 hours before procedure. If you wear contacts: please remove them at home or bring your contact lens supplies with you if you don't have glasses to wear. Please leave jewelry and other valuables at home.	2 Days Prior Drink at least four 8oz. glasses of water throughout the day. NO Solid Foods after midnight! You will begin a clear liquid diet at midnight. Acceptable clear liquids include: water, clear broth, apple juice, white cranberry juice, white grape juice, soda, jello, popsicles, coffee, and tea. You may have any transparent liquid. Nothing with milk or creamer. Nothing red, blue	1 Day Prior Clear liquid diet all day today. Drink at least four 8oz. glasses of water throughout the day. Do NOT drink alcohol the day before your procedure. If you are taking diabetic medication, cut your dose in half this day and do not take any diabetic medication day of procedure. 5pm: Colyte Prep- (Part 1) Step 1- Add cool water to line on container. Close and shake to dissolve. Add Flavor Pack to Container if not already added. Step 2- Drink 8oz of solution every 15 minutes until 75% (3/4) has been consumed. You should be done by 9pm. Step 3- Store the remainder of the solution in the refrigerator overnight. If you are unable to tolerate the prep, please call 410-224-4887 to speak to the on call	Clear liquid diet until 4 hours prior to your procedure. Morning Dose Colyte (Part 2) 5 hours prior to your procedure: Drink 8oz of solution every 15 minutes until rest of solution has been consumed. This should be completed within one hour. You must finish all of the prep, including the water 4 hours prior to your procedure. Please call the office if your prep results are not clear like water or a transparent yellow at this time. You cannot have ANYTHING AT AL by mouth for at least 4 hours prior to scheduled procedure time. This includes ice, water, gum, hard cand and mints. Take 1st Fleets Enema 2 hours prior to your scheduled arrival time. Take 2nd Fleets Enema 1 hour prior to your scheduled arrival time No smoking the day of procedure.
